5. Perpetrators include those directly carrying out the persecution, as well as those who made policies, issued orders, and assisted in the persecution.
6. According to the U.S. immigration laws, crimes that will trigger denial of visas include:
 - (1) Extrajudicial killing (defined as deliberated killing not authorized by a previous judgment pronounced by a regularly constituted court affording all the judicial guarantees)
 - (2) Torture or cruel, inhuman, or degrading treatment or punishment;
 - (3) Prolonged detention without charges;
 - (4) Causing the disappearance of persons by the abduction or clandestine detention of those persons
 - (5) Other flagrant denial of the right to life, liberty, or the security of persons.
 - (6) Ordering, inciting, assisting, or otherwise participating in genocide.
